
My Sister the Vampire: Switched by Sienna Mercer (Egmont, £5.99)

Buttercup Mash by Joanna Nadin (OUP, £6.99)



My Story: Titanic by Ellen Emerson White



Dizzy by Cathy Cassidy (Puffin, £6.99)



Frankie Foster: Fizzy Pop! by Jean Ure (HARPER COLLINS, £5.99)


Frankie loves to fix other people's problems. But when she tries to help an adopted friend to find her real mum, will Frankie cause a sticky situation?
