What is a plural?

O Recap

Plural means 'more than one'. **Singular** means 'only one'. There are rules for spelling plural words.

B Revise

For most words, to change a word from singular to plural, you add an **s** on the end. However there are a lot of exceptions to this rule! Here are some examples:

Add es

when the word ends in **ch**, **sh**, **ss**, **x** or **o**.

Singular	Plural
chur ch	chur ches
wi sh	wi shes
dre ss	dresses
box	bo xes
potat o	potat oes





Add es and change y to i when the word ends in y with a consonant before it.

Singular	Plural
par ty	par ties
butterf ly	butterfli es





Add es and change f to v when the word ends in a f sound (including ife, where the final e

is not the last sound)

Singular	Plural
hal f	hal ves
loaf	loa ves
kn ife	kni ves



Or

just learn these irregular plurals – they don't follow the rules!

Singular	Plural
tooth	teeth
foot	feet
person	people
