CECILY doesn't go to school – there aren't any schools in her town. She helps her mother with her work. They make cloth and work in their garden. She's twelve years old - ready for marriage. She likes a boy in her town. but he's from a very poor family. She can't be his wife. Marriage isn't about love, it's about money. Her father is looking for a good husband for her.

ELEANOR is fourteen years old. She lives in a convent and wants to be a nun. She sees her family every month, but she can never leave the convent. She can read and write – she has lessons from the nuns. But nuns can't dance or eat nice food, and they can't have husbands or children. Eleanor goes to the chapel at 2 o'clock every night, and five times every day. She helps in the convent hospital too.

An abbess governs the nuns in a convent. In 1200, it is the only good job for a woman without an important husband.

EDWARD is eleven and he comes from an important family. He wants to be a knight. He doesn't live with his family. He lives in a castle and has lessons there. He can read, but his important lessons are horseriding and swordfighting. There are very young boys at the castle with him. Some are only seven.



Robin Hood and Sir Guy of Gisborne are knights. They are good at swordfighting after years of lessons like Edward's.
